



Hilfield Monthly Clubs



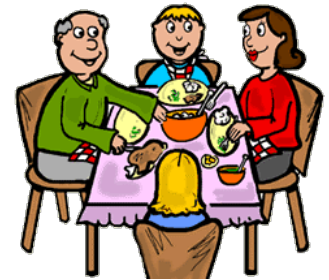
